## Summer Housing Charges & Assignments (Undergraduate & Graduate Students)

- All summer 2022 housing and dining fees will be charged to student fee bills once a resident moves into their summer housing assignment.
- Summer housing is billed as a weekly flat rate, where one week is Sunday through Saturday.
- Bills are generated once per month for the month ahead. Billing dates are expected to be: May 12, June 3, and July 14.
- Residential Life will inform residents of their specific housing assignment at the time of check-in.
- **Double Occupancy Assignments** Most summer residents will be placed in traditional double occupancy rooms in Werth Tower. Residents should expect to have a roommate. Please work with the Center for Students with Disabilities if you require an alternative housing assignment.

## **Undergraduate Students Eligibility and Verification for Housing**

• Eligibility for Undergraduate Summer 2022 Housing
Summer residents must be registered for 1+ Storrs campus summer courses, work or intern oncampus during the dates housing is requested, be an athlete required to live on campus, or be a student unable to safely return home. Supporting documentation will be required prior to

### Verification of Eligibility

- Summer coursework will be verified though University records.
- Student athlete requirements will be verified through Athletics.
- Students who are unable to return home will need to submit information about their personal circumstances to livingoncampus@uconn.edu
- Individuals who are participating in an academic internship or who are working on-campus must provide proof of their employment/participation to Residential Life. An email from the employment or academic supervisor is required.

Supervisors should email <u>livingoncampus@uconn.edu</u> with the following information:

- Include student's first name, last name, and 7 digit student ID number or NetID
- State that the student will be completing an internship or is employed by the department
- Dates of internship/employment

#### **Summer Meal Plans**

All residents living in Werth will be assigned the meal plan selected in this application.

- Residents who have purchased a summer meal plan and cancel it, will be charged for the full period of the week that they cancelled.
- Summer meal plans include 1 breakfast, 1 lunch, and 1 dinner per day. Unused meals do not rollover to the following day.
- Residents enrolled in a summer class may change their meal plan for each term they are enrolled until the third day of classes. After you've checked-in, please contact Dining Services at (860) 486-3128 to make changes during this window.
- Residents working or interning on campus may change their meal plan up until their third day living on campus. After you've check-in, please contact Dining Services at (860) 486-3128 to make changes during this window.

### **Graduate Students**

- **Eligibility for Graduate Summer 2022 Housing:** Must be a Spring 2022 on-campus graduate resident.
- Spring 2022 graduate on-campus residents who do not have Fall 2022 on-campus housing can stay in summer housing only through June 30, 2022.

## **Dietary Restrictions**

Residents with dietary restrictions or special dietary needs should contact Dining Services at (860) 486-3128 about meal options.

### Housing Accommodations for Residents with Disabilities or a Medical Condition

Residents with a documented health/medical condition or disability which may impact their living environment must contact the <u>Center for Students with Disabilities</u> to register and request a housing accommodation. Current students who already are registered should notify their CSD case manager that they will need a summer housing accommodation.

## **Transition to Fall 2022 Housing**

• August 19, 2022: All summer residents living on-campus as of August 19, 2022 will transition to their Fall 2022 assignment at no additional cost by this date. Transition instructions will be sent in August 2022 via University email. If a summer resident does not have Fall housing oncampus, they will need to move out by noon on August 19, 2022.

### **Cancellations/Changes**

 Residents who wish to cancel their summer housing contract or change their assignment dates, must email <u>livingoncampus@uconn.edu</u> and include their full name, student ID number, and clearly state the cancellation request or date change.
